5 Number Magic in Our Chronos (Gregorian) Calendar

There are 5 Mondays, 5 Tuesdays, and 5 Wednesdays in July 2019. In fact every year any month that has 31 days has a series of three days that occur five times in that month.

I first became aware of this in July, 2011 when there were 5 Fridays, 5 Saturdays, and 5 Sundays and for some reason that was getting a lot of attention. I remember seeing several sources saying this was a rare event that only occurred every 823 years. Since this is a feature of the day of the week any month happens to begin I remember feeling skeptical of that claim however I was intrigued by the awareness of the magical 5's gaining so much attention in my 55th year.



Contrary to the notion it would be 823 years before this calendric event would happen again – it reoccurred in July of 2016 and it will reoccur in July 2022 and July 2028 as part of a regular pattern that repeats around every 6 years though it can be affected by a leap year as was the case in 2016.

May 2020 features 5 Fridays, 5 Saturdays, and 5 Sundays and 6 years later **May 2026** repeats this pattern - so again this is nothing special or unusual.

This means any month that has 31 days and begins on a Friday will have 5 Fridays, 5 Saturdays, and 5 Sundays. If the 31-day month begins on a Saturday there will be 5 Saturdays, 5 Sundays and 5 Monday. If a 31-day Month begins on a Monday there will be 5 Mondays, 5 Tuesdays and 5 Wednesdays or if a 31-day month begins on Tuesday, it will have 5 Tuesdays, 5 Wednesdays, and 5 Thursdays featuring the middle of the week and so on.

Most months feature 5 in some way but unless it is a month with 31 days it won't have three days of the week show up 5 times in a month. Since our calendar is not astrologically based this doesn't have meaning from that perspective however the number magic still has significance worth noting.

For example, another monthly pattern that has captured my attention in the past is month's beginning on a Sunday always feature the notorious Friday the 13th believed to be unlucky – though now that myth is being dispelled. In 2019, 2021, 2022, 2024 Friday the 13th occurs only once during the year. Friday the 13th occurs twice in the years 2020 and 2023 and three times in 2026. 2019 December - **2020** March and November (Leap Year) - **2021** August - 2022 May - **2023** January and October
2024 December (Leap Year)

5 is the number of adventure, radical change and transformation. 5 is a prime number (as is 55) and one of the numbers of the Golden Mean or Golden Ratio and is one the most predominate patterns found in nature as many plants and flowers and even fruits have a distinct fivefold symmetry.

July 1. Venus slips into the underworld moving through the last gate into the underworld before moving so close to the Sun she disappears to be with the Sun until September 19 when she rises as evening star. Stay tuned for other important underworld features including an August underworld meeting with Mars. (see below for more on this remarkable event)

Retrograde Mercury catches up with the Sun on July 21. Something to keep in mind is Mercury will transit the face of the Sun on November 11 of this year. More about Mercury Retrograde and how to make the most of this time at this link <https://cayelincastell.com/mercury-retrograde/>

Note: Mercury and Mars were stunning in the western sky in June in one of their closest alignments in years and at that time Mercury was brighter than Mars. Both planets are still within 4° as July begins.

Mars shines at a 1.9° magnitude all of July. However, Mars comes within 15° of the Sun on July 17 and does not rise in the morning sky 15° ahead of the Sun until November. Meaning Mars is experiencing an underworld initiation and will meet with Venus on August 24 in a rare underworld alignment that hasn't happened in this season of the year in 32 years.

Venus, Mars and Mercury in the Underworld

As July begins Mars is about 4° to the right of Mercury and on July 3 is about 3° to the upper left of the very thin Crescent Moon all three very low in the WNW after sunset mainly visible to those in the southerly latitudes of North America.

By the end of the second week of July Venus, Mars and retrograde Mercury will all be with the Sun. This council meeting of the inner planets with the Sun suggests it is time to source new ways of experience the Sacred Feminine and Masculine energies as the consider new ways of doing relationship, including new styles of communicating that are compassionate, nurturing and safe.

Venus is about 6° left of the waning crescent Moon on July 1 low on the ENE horizon Rising about 30 minutes before sunrise. This means it will be difficult to see the Moon and Venus together. This represents the 8th gate the Goddess is descending through on her way to her underworld initiation beginning July 8.

Venus Moon conjunction July 1 are by the Horns of the Bull invoking the imagery of “taking the bull by its horns” or being challenge by the “horns of a dilemma” that often does NOT have a clear and easy answer.

The horns of the Bull are on the eastern edge of the Milky Way crossing the Ecliptic creating a Galactic Cross in the sky. This helps to explain why the Bull has such an important role in the Egyptian conception of how one enters the Elysian Fields as the hero/ine must pass by the bull that guards the route to the West, or the Elysian Fields.

El Nath (aka Zeta Tarui) marks the northern tip of horn of the Bull (22 Gemini 51)
Al Hecka marks the southern tip of the horn (25 Gemini 03)

In classical mythology, the Elysian Fields was a place of blessedness and peace where everything was delightful, with soft green meadows, lovely groves, a delicious life-giving air and sunlight that glowed softly purple.

When Planets are between the Horns of the Bull it could be seen as a test of strength and courage to encounter the Bull – the Guardian of the Gateway to the Elysian Fields before passing through to a better life in the Elysian Fields.

Are you willing? And if so are you ready?

The question is: what is the

dilemma or challenge we are being asked to reconcile? In the world of duality one answer might be found in the reconciliation of the paradox we experience around the seeming conflict between our ego and divine nature.

Taking a closer look at the stars Alhecka and Elnath gives us further clues into what this might mean for us.

Alhecka has been referred to as “the Heavenly Gate” and was considered to have a mischievous influence – much like the trickster Mercury. [Star Names, Their Lore and Meaning, Richard Hinckley Allen, 1889]. This suggests that the

trickster aspect of Mercury who is also a messenger – loving to explore beyond the confines of duality – is being amplified by the light codes coming from Alhecka.

Elnath is also a part of this Timing as it marks the other Horn of the Bull. It is interesting to note that Elnath is a blue-white star about 700 times the fire power of our Sun. Considering the surface temperature of the Sun is at about 10,000 degrees Fahrenheit and Elnath is at around 24,000 degrees Fahrenheit (more than double), it is easy to see that Elnath has a huge energetic delivery – more than twice what our Sun has though of course is so much further away from the Earth. Still when planets are in this area of the sky they are receiving the energy Elnath is generating.

The Horns of the Bull are a symbol for the challenge we experience in this realm of duality. The star Elnath represents perseverance and breakthroughs, and Al Hecka is the opposite representing stalemates, standoffs and blind habitual fighting. This creates the “horns of dilemma” that we often find ourselves experiencing.

Since Elnath is nearly directly opposite the center of our galaxy (a.k.a Galactic Center) it has the ability to expand your horizons, free you from limiting influences and align you with the heart of our galaxy and its blessings.

So again with Venus aligned here we can imagine this is opening additional light portals, beaming them directly to Earth and further activating our DNA. We know this because Science is finding our DNA responds to light – including starlight. In fact we are made of the same stuff as the stars.

One way to tune into this Timing for the first part of July is to consider the following question;

What messages, insights, and aha's, that include remembering NOT to take ourselves too seriously and NOT to necessarily believe everything we think, are being activated?

Magnifying the Underworld Initiatory Energy

July 21 Venus is opposite Pluto on July 21 creating an additional initiatory opportunity for Venus in her current descent to the underworld. **On August 13 Venus meets with the Sun** and remains in the underworld until September 19.

Pluto is an underworld initiator (a.k.a. Erishikegal the Dark Goddess of the Underworld). Venus opposite Pluto while in the underworld magnifies the power of the underworld initiation creating an opportunity to experience even greater empowerment by confronting and embracing any remaining fears or shadow parts of ourselves we have disowned or denied.

This Initiation requires intentional surrender (Pluto and the underworld) to any attachments to the old ways. One way to think about this is to consider how to revision a prevailing myth of the feminine that comes to us through the story of Persephone (Venus) and Hades (Pluto).

This mythic story has been handed down through many generations of the patriarchy describing the abduction and rape of Persephone. Basically the story of Persephone as told from this perspective reflects a vicious and malicious patriarchal takeover of the feminine initiatory process, where Persephone is taken against her will to the underworld and then subjugated to Hades WILL by sheer force of his brute strength. Inanna and Ishtar's story on the other hand describes them making a conscious choice to engage the underworld initiation without being forced or coerced.



Re-imagining this myth – and retelling it as a coming of age story might include Hades actually respectfully asking for Persephone's hand in marriage.

In the original telling we could imagine Demeter says NO, not now, not ever. What Demeter might not know is perhaps young Persephone wants to be with Hades and to be his queen.

Demeter would NOT want Persephone to marry Hades mainly because it would mean she is separated from her daughter, who goes off to live in the underworld. Persephone, however, if it is her choice to go would insist and even defy her mother's wishes. If Persephone desires to claim her rite of passage and empowerment as a Queen of the Underworld – realizing her job includes welcoming the newly dead or those being initiated in this realm (returning this rite of passage as a conscious choice to all people) - she would likely feel this is an important sacred work for her to embrace.



As we continue to re-imagine this myth, we could imagine Persephone and Hades both negotiating with Mom otherwise known as Demeter - assuring her that her daughter would not only be fulfilling her destiny but she would also return to visit her mother every spring.

This mythic revisioning includes the importance of honoring ceremonial rites of passage including creating ways that support mothers in letting go of their children when it is time to pass the mantle, trusting their children will find their own way.

Telling the story in this way includes supporting the children (in this story the daughters) to walk their own path - ceremonially turning over the responsibility for making their own decisions as they reach the age of maturity.

The Venus Meta Goddess on the world stage from November 1, 2018 to June 09, 2020 is Libra. She is very interested in conscious, co-creative, and collaborative relationships where each person in the relationship has equal value for what they bring. We could imagine that Hades then would NOT force Peresphone to join him against her will but would rather invite the best possible way to engage an equal relationship that serves the best interests of all involved.

As July begins Venus shines at a -3.9 magnitude however very low on the eastern horizon before sunrise. According to Sky and Telescope Venus doesn't disappear from the morning sky until July 22. However Venus is within 10° of the Sun on July 8 so technically not visible and much depends on your horizon line. Some may not see her now, others may see her past the July 8 date.

Jupiter reached opposition to the Sun on June 10 and is a commanding presence in the night sky at a brilliant -2.6 magnitude. By the end of July Jupiter fades to a -2.4 magnitude. If you are around 40° North latitude Jupiter is setting about 2 AM by the end of July. Jupiter is culminating or at the highest point around 11:30 PM in early July and culminating around 9 PM at the end of July. Jupiter is a retrograde until August 11.

Saturn reaches opposition to the Sun on July 9 so is visible all night throughout this month. Saturn shines it's golden light at magnitude +0.1 to the left of the Archer.

It's worth noting where Jupiter and Saturn are in the sky now as we have an opportunity to watch them move closer together as the rest of 2019 unfolds.

Significant July Event Dates

Jul 02 Venus enters Cancer and is on the Galactic Cross at the Galactic Edge

Jul 04 Earth at Perihelion features the annual **aphelion** of the Earth to Sun meaning Earth is furthest from the Sun in its annual cycle exact at 6:11 pm EDT or 3:11 pm PDT.

July 05. The waxing Crescent Moon is less than 3° to the right of Regulus around dusk.

July 06. Sun conjunct Sirius <https://cayelincastell.com/sirius-star-magic/> Sirius was the most important star in Egyptian cosmology because when it rose in the morning sky before the Sun it signaled the annual rise of the Nile river – a life giving event for the Egyptians.

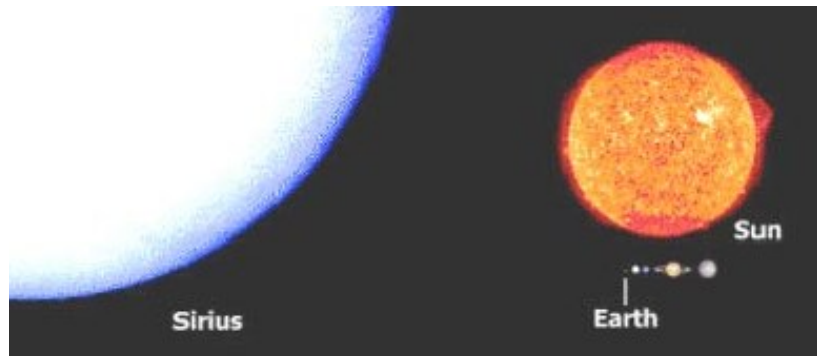
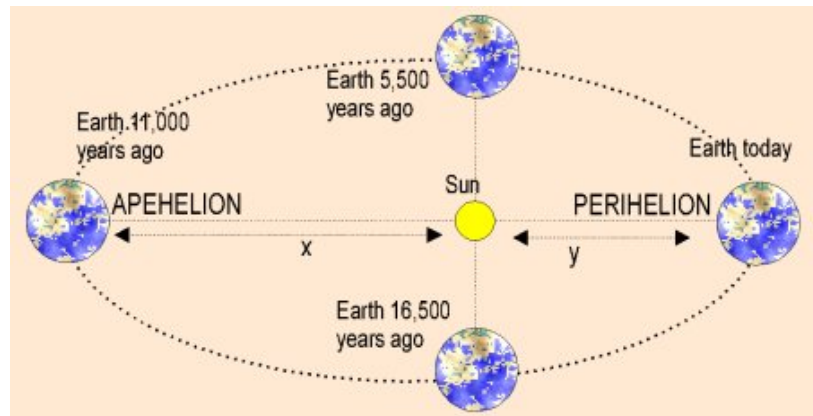
"Contrary to other rivers, [the Nile] begins its annual swelling in the hottest time of the year, at the beginning of the Dog Days, that is, at the moment when Sirius rises at the same time as the Sun, a date which during the third millennium BC coincided with the summer solstice." - Lucy Lamie, Egyptian Mysteries

The Sun with Sirius is activating this star gate - opening the doorway to the wisdom found in many multi-dimensional realms. This includes the knowledge and remembrance of our starry origins. (see July 17)

*...Entrusted with the wisdom and knowledge of an earlier and now forgotten civilization, the Ancient Egyptians believed that Sirius held the key to the destiny of their world, and to their own personal immortality. Their beliefs were based on a series of texts, already ancient in their time, which described special "**Star Medicines**" that resonated with the energy of Sirius and were capable of transforming their bodies into a higher immortal form. In the "Maxims of Ptahotep", we are all urged, "Follow the Heart for as long as you live", for it is this organ that retains the greatest sensitivity to the harmonizing, archetypal forces of Sirius, it becomes our "listening place", for the Sirian/Isian message of Eternal Love, Knowledge, and Understanding. From now until the September Equinox the light codes from Sirius are amping up and are worth tuning into even though Sirius will not be visible in the morning sky until around early August.

July 09. The Sun is conjunct the North Node (17°Cn38' D)



July 12. The waxing Gibbous Moon forms a triangle with Jupiter and Antares at dusk until like 12 and there's only about 4° from Jupiter the next night around dusk.

July 14 Although not a visible planet retrograde Pluto reaches opposition to the Sun marking the anniversary of the new horizons spacecraft having passed closest to Pluto in 2015. Pluto and Saturn are moving closer and closer together reaching their exact conjunction in 2020.

July 15. the nearly Full Moon is with Saturn about 2° to the left. Viewers around 40° North latitude will see Saturn about 1/3 of the way into the sky when it's at its highest southern point around 1:30 AM on July 1 and around 11:30 PM July 31.

July 16. Partial Full Moon Eclipse (24° Cp04') near Terebellum in the Archer.

Jul 21. Venus opposite Pluto. This poem by my oldest son when he was just 18 sums up one possible experience we can have in an underworld initiation magnified by Pluto seeking a way to surrender to the underworld initiation. I have shared this a few times before and feedback to me is how helpful it is to realize this is descriptive of the underworld experience. It is from this place of surrendering to the powerlessness one can feel in an underworld initiation that is when true transformation begins in ways that we can't even imagine before this happens.

July 22, Magdalene's Feast Day. The Sun moves into Leo. When Leo is in its strength and power this energy knows and remembers its radiant and shining divine essence shared by all life. A favorite quote in the Celestial Timings over the years has included these words by [Marianne Williamson](#) in her book *A Return to Love*. This part of the quote sums up the essence of the Leo mysteries.

We are born to make manifest the Glory of God that is within us. It's not just in some of us; it's in everyone. And as we let our own Light shine, we unconsciously give other people permission to do the same. As we are liberated from our own fear, our presence automatically liberates others.

July 27. the Moon is with Aldebaran about 6° the lower left of this Behenian Royal star the following morning.

July 28. Archangel Uriel's Feast Day. In the Book of Enoch Uriel is described as "the Light of God". This archangel is also connected to the fixed star Antares and the direction of the West. **In the book *The Blessed Virgin Mary* author Corinne Heline states:**

"The beautiful Uriel stands guardian over the activities of the summer. The ripening of grain and the floodtide of blossom are under his guidance. He also supervises the Nature Spirits, those fascinating little sprites who inhabit the elements of earth, air, fire and water, and who lend so much to the beautification of all nature. The highest initiatory teachings belonging to the New Age...are under the direction of Uriel." [New Age Press, 1971, p. 110.]



July 31. Second New Moon of July (08°Le37') with Praesaepe in the Beehive cluster in the constellation of the Crab. **The Beehive Cluster** (or M44 as the astronomers have named it) or **Praesepe** a Latin word for manger is an open cluster (one of the largest in this area of the sky) of stars located at about 7 degrees of the seasonal sign Leo and in the constellation of the Crab (a.k.a Cancer).

This cluster does very much look like a swarm of stars with more than 40 stars visible to the naked eye as a cloudy patch. The Beehive Cluster is only visible under dark skies. It was one the first objects that Galileo studied with his telescope. The best way to find the Beehive Cluster is to first locate the twin stars Pollux and Castor. Then looking left or to the east locate Regulus at the base of the backward question mark.

The Beehive Cluster lies somewhere in between Pollux and Regulus and is difficult to see unless you are under a very dark sky because even though it is a 3rd magnitude cluster it is spread about a degree and half across the sky with its light spreading over an area bigger than three full Moons. Generally, it is easier to spot if you have binoculars. However, the tiny crescent Moon will be very nearby just after Sunset as the sky darkens acting as a marker to help you locate these stars. Castor and Pollux will have most likely just set or are about to set depending on the time of the Sunset where you are.



Some of the sky lore of this constellation is that it represents the crab that bit the heel of Hercules <http://www.constellationsofwords.com/Constellations/Hercules.html> during his fight with the Lernean Hydra <http://www.constellationsofwords.com/Constellations/Hydra.html> , and was placed amongst the stars in gratitude by Juno, the enemy of Hercules. [Robson*, p.33.]

In ancient times this cluster often served to predict the weather; if not crystal clear inclement weather might be on the way. Pliny said, *"If Praesaepe is not visible in a clear sky it is a presage of a violent storm"*. <http://www.constellationsofwords.com/stars/Praesaepe.html>

Sky Happenings for July 2019

In the Month of July the constellation of the Bull (a.k.a Taurus – the constellation NOT the seasonal sign) rises before the Sun. Featured in this constellation are the Pleiades (marking the shoulder of the Bull) and Aldebaran, one of the four royal stars of ancient times.

This is also a [Behenian Star](#) marking the eye of the Bull, representing the enlightened mind. Star lore varies from culture to culture but often carries similar themes. For example, the Pleiades as the seven sisters shows up in both Native American star lore as well as Greek and Roman.

Other stories refer to the Pleiades as a Stargate - transmitting the divine light of creation in ways that are intended to help enlighten our minds, increase our knowing, and inspire the wisdom that is always available to us when we are tuned in to it.

In the month of July the Sun is passing through the constellation of the Twins and the Sacred Hoop until about July 20. The Sun is the source of light and life for planet Earth, the strongest physical symbol we have for a direct experience of pure source energy. It also represents our physical consciousness, helping to harmonize Will and Spirit or the physical with the spiritual.

Sirius and the Declaration of Independence

It is also interesting to note that the Sun and Sirius were conjunct when the signing of the United States Declaration of Independence took place back in 1776. Many believe that this cosmic event was purposely planned by our founding Fathers to coincide with the time when the Sun was conjunct Sirius.

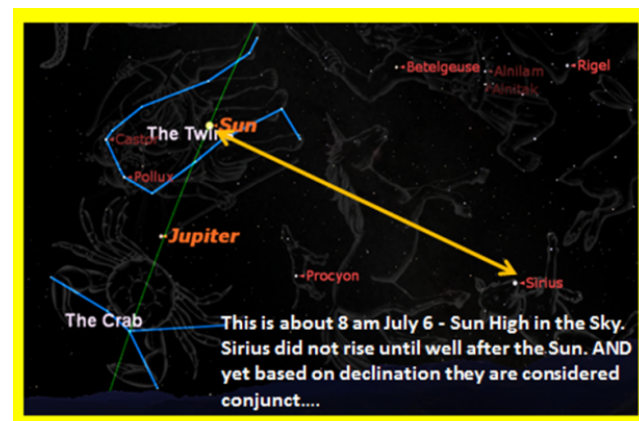


It is interesting to note that many of the founding fathers were Free Masons suggesting they knew about the importance and power of Sirius. Sirius is one of the primary symbols of Freemasonry described as the “Blazing Star” of omnipresence and omniscience or all seeing and all knowing.

Sirius is therefore the “sacred place” all Masons must ascend to: It is the source of divine power and the destination of divine individuals. More [HERE](#)

Not only was Sirius conjunct the Sun at the time of the signing of the Declaration of Independence it later became prominently placed on the back of the dollar bill. This suggests the influence of the Free Masons and the Rosicrucians as both of these mystery schools are based in Egyptian Star Lore and Mythology with Sirius being central to both.

The light behind the All-Seeing Eye on the American dollar bill is not from the Sun, but from Sirius. The Great Pyramid of Giza was built in alignment with Sirius and is therefore shown shining right above the Pyramid. A radiant tribute to Sirius is therefore in the pockets of millions of citizens. Whenever planets are with Sirius, one of [Behenian Stars](#) - the ancient alchemist believed this was the best time to make amulets and potions or to activate ceremonial intentions.

The Sun is within 6 degrees of Sirius from June 30 to July 15.

Generally a star is not visible when within 10 degrees of the Sun. For Sirius this currently happens from June 25 to July 17. However it is worthwhile to note, Sirius often does not emerge from the Sun's glow until early August depending on your horizon line.

The "the dog days of summer" occur when the Sun is with Sirius a term that comes to us from several different cultures that recognized the time of year when the Sun was with Sirius the "Dog Star".

Many ancient cultures describe Sirius as a dog or wolf. The ancient Chinese saw this star as a heavenly wolf. In Sumeria, Babylonia and Chaldea (present day Iraq) Sirius was known as the "Dog Star that Leads," or it was called the "Star of the Dog." In Assyria, this star was called the "Dog of the Sun." In ancient Akkadia, it was the "Dog Star of the Sun." Clearly Sirius has been viewed by many cultures as a Dog Star. As the Sun, Mercury and Venus pass by here over the next few weeks it may be worth tuning into Dog and Wolf medicine for guidance and support as we journey through these Summer "Dog Days" ... <http://www.constellationsofwords.com/stars/Sirius.html>

"Dog days" is the name for the sultriest period of summer, from about July 3 to August 11. Named in early times by observers in countries bordering the Mediterranean, the period was reckoned as extending from 20 days before to 20 days after the conjunction of Sirius (a.k.a the dog star) and the Sun....The time of conjunction varies with difference in latitude, and because of the precession of the equinoxes it changes gradually over long periods in all latitudes. <http://www.infoplease.com/spot/dogdays.html>
