

When my mom died I was 42 and suddenly I was the oldest living female in my family line. I felt I was just a kid myself then so even though I knew it was true I couldn't relate to that reality. Partly because 22 years ago when my Mom died I was still a busy mom myself and I deeply felt the loss of support that was no longer available to me. It took me a few years to realize I had all the wisdom I needed to be a good Mom even though all the elder women had left me.



I do find myself 22 years later still not quite sure what it means to be the elder woman (and literally elder on all fronts) of my family line? This is partly because I still feel more like a teenager than an adult much less an elder. I do love it when someone is clearly surprised to find out how old I am especially since I just turned 64. My youthful perception of myself has its good side and its more challenging side – something I will explore more deeply.

Meanwhile, it is exciting to be a Grandmother and have a new grand baby - even if the corona virus has created a reality where we haven't had a chance to meet our grandson yet. Trusting that will happen when the time is divinely aligned for everyone!


### Stars worth noting in the Night Sky this Month

This month the Milky Way is seen lying flat around the horizon so not clearly visible unless you look up to the Northeast highest part in Cygnus the Swan. However this position of the Milky Way gives us the sense of the Plane of the Galaxy. Plus, when looking Northeast toward Cygnus Galactic Center is to your right.



Also prominent this month is the constellation of the Virgin Priestess (a.k.a. Virgo) containing seven main stars. The most visible star in this group is the bright bluish white star Spica, meaning "spike of grain." Higher in the sky and a bit to the right of Spica is the star Denebola forming the lion's tail in the constellation also known as Leo.

If you follow a direct line from Spica to the upper left you will see the bright red star Arcturus. These three stars Arcturus, Denebola, and Spica form what is sometimes called the Spring Triangle best viewed from April to June. Plus, we have the perfect 30-60-90 degree triangle formed by Arcturus, Spica and Regulus (the heart of the lion). Look East South East to spot both triangles. (See August 2007 Archives for more about Arcturus, Spica and Regulus triangle.)



# Venus goes Retrograde on May 12, 2020

## Metamorphosis - the Heart of the Venus Retrograde

Over the course of the 584.5 day Venus Synodic Cycle Venus is Retrograde for an average of 40 days or about 14% of the cycle.

### Averages

16 days in the evening sky

08 days with the Sun

16 days in the morning sky

The 8 days with the Sun is Metamorphic Underworld at the end of Venus cycle where the Goddess/Venus undergoes a rapid and complete metamorphosis into a new Goddess Archetype.

### What it Means?

A magical, mysterious time when we are invited to die a good death letting go of our old limiting identities so we can be reborn completely anew to our true selves.



**Venus** begins this month about 35° above the Western horizon though that can vary based on your latitude. Venus is setting about 3 1/2 hours of after the Sun as May begins and only a half hour after the Sun by the end of month. Plus, Venus begins her 40 day retrograde on May 12.

**Venus** is shining at -4.7 magnitude near her maximum brightness as May begins very close to one of the horns of the Bull - a star called El Nath. Venus ends the month at -4.2 magnitude and conjuncts the Sun on June 3.


**Venus stationing retrograde near the stars marking the Horns of the bull takes us back to the Venus transits of 2004 and 2012 that occurred in this exact area of the sky.** We will not again experience a Venus Transit in our lifetime and definitely not in this area of the sky but we can imagine something powerful was seeded in 2004 and 2012 that is playing out each time Venus goes retrograde in this part of the sky. We can add to the intentions that were set then and



tune into what more we want to energize as the Rainbow Goddess helps us to ignite our Rainbow Light Body. (Stay tuned for more on that)

I got to see the Venus Transit in 2012 on the big Island of Hawaii with an intentional group. We ceremonially witnessed this rare event and it was powerful. Since that time the sacred site near Green Lake where we gathered for the Venus Transit no longer exists due to recent volcanic activity. The lake has drained and the land has been transformed.

This Venus cycle is the first to occur in this part of the sky since the 2012 Venus Transit that was a powerful seed point for further awakening of the divine feminine within and around us.



Taking time to notice look at Venus in this area of the sky (before disappearing with the Sun near the end of May) helps you attune to the incoming light codes that are being amplified by Venus and the Moon on May 23 and connect with the seeds planted back in 2012. Many ancient cultures looked to this area of the sky for special Celestial Events to let them know when the ages were shifting as described below.

The Great Bull of Heaven is linked with the end of each of the four ages; (the bull it is said) withdraws one of its hooves from the ground. When all are free the foundations of the world will be destroyed. Shiva's 'perfect horn' is the crescent Moon. The first letter of the Hebrew alphabet is 'aleph', which means "bull", and is the symbol of the Moon in its first week and also the name of the sign of the zodiac where the Moon's mansions begin (ELIT p.178). Many letters of the alphabet, hieroglyphs and ideograms are simultaneously associated with the phases of the Moon and with the bull's horns, the latter often compared with the crescent Moon.



6,500 years ago the ancients knew we were at a Turning of an Age when they saw the Crescent Moon near the Horns of the Bull at the Spring Equinox. We are now one quarter turn of the 26,000 year wheel later when the Summer Solstice is located where the Spring Equinox was 6,500 years ago.

Clearly it is no accident that we have chosen to be here on Earth at this time as witness to this grand cosmic unfolding. Our conscious participation, appreciation and awareness of these events helps determine what is now seeking manifestation through what we are imagining and energizing in our hearts. As Carl Jung reminded us it is essential as conscious participants with this significant turning of the great galactic wheel that we “dream the dream onward”

**Just Prior to the Moon catching up to Venus it is passing Aldebaran on May 23 the key to the Silver Gate.**

*... the Silver Gate is above Orion, at the center of the Duat; the Egyptian Netherworld which was represented on the ground in the Giza area. The Silver Gate is just above the “hand” of Orion, who the Egyptians associated with Osiris, and they depicted him holding a star in his hand. In the Orion Mystery, Bauval & Gilbert presumed this to be the star Aldebaran. Now, Gilbert has found that the Egyptian word for star, s’ba, also means “door”, so Osiris is holding a Star-Gate. In some depictions, Osiris is holding an ankh towards the gate, so this must be the key which unlocks the star gate.* <http://www.diagnosis2012.co.uk/7.htm>



**Venus** decreases to 23° above the horizon after sunset on May 15 and it’s only 3° above the horizon by the end of the month.

**A New Venus 19-month Cycle begins June 09** and a New Ceremonial Venus Journey with Venus Alchemy begins in early July before the first Venus Moon conjunction. Venus rises closest to the royal star Aldebaran in this 104 year journey of Venus with the Gemini Goddess.

Plus the North Node and Venus are coming together twice in 2020 and again in 2021. Something that hasn’t happened in about 56 years. These and other factors are promising and hopeful in a time when that is exactly what we need.

**Mercury** becomes visible in evening twilight around May 11 shining at -1.5 magnitude well below Venus. Mercury climbs higher as Venus is sinking lower coming closest together on May 21 when Mercury is just 1° to the lower left of Venus. By that time Mercury has faded to a -0.7 magnitude and Venus is around -4.4 magnitude. Mercury reaches greatest elongation from the Sun on June 4. **Jupiter and Saturn** appear within 5° of each other for the entire month of May located on either side of the constellations of the archer where Jupiter is and the goat fish where Saturn is located.

**Saturn** stations retrograde on May 10 at 1° Aquarius 57 and **Jupiter** stations retrograde on May 14 at 27° Capricorn 14'.

**Jupiter Saturn** are less than 5° on May 18 when Jupiter is just 4.7° west southwest of Saturn. This is considered “quasi-conjunction”. This occurs when two objects don’t share the same right ascension or ecliptic longitude yet reached a minimum separation of 5° or less from each other.

After May 18 Jupiter is Retrograding away from Saturn Moving more quickly than Saturn. Jupiter and Saturn will make an ultra close conjunction on December 21 of this year.



**Both Jupiter and Saturn rise around 1:30 AM as May begins** and around 11:30 PM by the end of the month.

**Jupiter** bright and slightly from a magnitude -2.4 to an even more impressive -2.6 during its retrograde and pattern is increasing, +0.6 to a +0.4 magnitude over this month.

**Mars** is rising before 3 AM as May begins at Around 2 AM by the end of the month. Mars is brightening from a magnitude 0.4 to 0. Remember the smaller the number the brighter the magnitude or the brighter the planet or star appears to us.

**Mars** is about 1° north northwest of the Star Nashira in the constellation of the goat fish. A 3.6 Magnitude star on May 1.

**Mars** which is about the same distance to the star Algedi on May 4 shift in from the constellation of the goat fit into the water bearer by May 9.



The waxing gibbous moon is a few degrees above regulus on May 1. The waning gibbous moon is a few degrees below Jupiter on May 12. On May 14 the moon and its last quarter phase is to the right of Mars.


And 30 minutes after sunset on May 23 a very thin Lunar Crescent is less than 5° to the lower left of Venus, with mercury is similar distance to the upper left of Venus.

## Comets are Wild Cards

You May remember the comet Pannstars from around May 2017 when it was discovered by the panoramic survey telescope and rapid response system.

At that time the comet object was beyond the orbit of Saturn. Three years later on May 4 it is making it's closest approach to the Sun (perhelion). This comet is NOT visible without a telescope or binoculars but should be observable through May into June as it passes near Ursa Major. The comet now known as comet T2 should be visible all night even from the southern United States. Comet T2 is traveling toward the big dipper at around 40 arc minutes per day increasing to 50 arc minutes after mid-May.

Under a dark sky with little interference from the Moon the comet will look like a fuzzy, pale blob in a pair of 15 mm or larger binoculars. Telescope users can see the details like a tale or a bright misty comma.

**May 01 is celebrated as May Day or Beltane and** it is also the 1684 May First Ascension Day of Saint Germain who brought us the alchemical gift of the Violet Flame. This is a great time to remember the power of invoking the Violet Flame for transmuting all energies that no longer serve our divine destiny. The Violet Flame is a gift assisting those who use it during these transformative times.



**May 05 is the Solar Beltane Cross-Quarter.** The Celts and other indigenous tribes at similar latitudes have celebrated the beginning of Summer at the Beltane Cross-Quarter and viewed the Summer Solstice as Mid-Summer. From this perspective the cross-quarter dates mark an in-between time ending and beginning the Celtic seasons. It is similar to the time of day just before Sunrise or just after Sunset ending and beginning day or night.



At the in-between point it is not yet fully day or fully night but a time when the veils are thin and access to other worldly realms is easier.



**May 05 is also known as Cinco de Mayo**, a day celebrated in remembrance of Mexico's 1862 historic battle for freedom. Today is also **the exact Astrological Solar Beltane** when the Sun crosses 15 Taurus **marking the exact half way point between the Spring Equinox and the Summer Solstice**. (See the image above) This is an extraordinary timing that the ancient Celts celebrated as an in-between time more easily stepping into a magical co-creative time that is connect with beauty, pleasure and the enjoyable abundance of life. When we are celebrating life with joy and gratitude we are connected to source and able to receive the generous provisions that fulfill all our needs and desires. The more genuinely grateful we are the more available this abundance is for us because we are open to receiving it.

Notice there are three planets stationing retrograde in May within 4 days of each other. Saturn May 10, Venus May 12, and Jupiter May 14. Creating an impressive Still Point. Pluto just went retrograde on April 25 so is still at one of its slowest points as well.

This gives us greater access into other realms and dimensions when we take the time to tune in and perhaps helps us to prepare for a month long eclipse window starting in June!
