June 2020 features Venus Retrograde conjunct the Sun on June 3, hanging out with the North Node for many weeks and beginning a new cycle on June 9/10 and then stations direct on June 24 at 5 Gemini. Mercury goes retrograde on June 17 at 14 Cancer with the star Sirius.

Mercury enters the degree of its station direct (05 Cancer 30) on June 1, 2020 and moves beyond its station retrograde degree on July 26, 2020.

Plus, June 5 opens a month long eclipse window (usually only two weeks) with the center point – Ring of Fire Annular Eclipse - exact on the June Solstice and the hand of Orion (a.k.a the High Man) suggesting this eclipse cauldron is extra potent. Celebrating your Blessings with gratitude is a powerful way to raise your personal vibration as well as the vibration of all those you encounter including the Earth.

So what is a blessing exactly?

The dictionary defines blessing as:

- 1. the act of invoking divine protection or aid
- 2. the words used in prayer or ceremony to invite or invoke the state of being blessed or blessing others
- 3. a short prayer of thanksgiving before or after a meal; also known as saying grace
- 4. a short prayer prescribed for a specific occasion or dedication of something like a wedding, or building, or project
- 5. approval; good wishes: as in parents giving their blessing to a field of study or vocation or a marriage
- 6. the bestowal of a divine gift or favor
- 7. a happy event or state of affairs such as being blessed by the birth of child or some other good fortune



Blessings come in many forms and all kinds of ways, some we recognize right away and some take longer to notice or fully understand. Traumatic events are often described as a blessing in disguise. It may take years

to see what the gift or blessing is. Even the most challenging events can be the biggest blessings when we are willing to shift and expand our point of view.



Stars worth noting in the June Night Sky

This month the Milky Way is seen lying flat around the horizon so not clearly visible unless you look up to the Northeast highest part in Cygnus the Swan. However this position of the Milky Way gives us the sense of the Plane of the Galaxy when looking Northeast toward Cygnus Galactic Center is to your right.

Last month the Milky Way was lying flat around the horizon so it was barely visible. **The Summer Triangle** is prominent now with the fixed star Deneb, the tail of Cygnus the Swan in the path of the Milky Way. **Cygnus** points toward the direction our Galaxy is moving. Vega, in the constellation of Lyra and was the pole star 13,000 years ago.




This is an ideal time to go out and look up at the Summer Triangle and open to receive downloads and insights from these prominent stars.

What are you seeing? Hearing? Sensing?

How are these stars guiding you toward your divine destiny?

Altair marks the eagle's eye and currently is at 1 Aquarius attuning to the BIG picture.




Vega is where Jody Foster goes in the movie Contact and as the brightest star in the constellation of Lyra seems to have links to the vibrational power of sound.

Deneb is the tail of the swan but also looks like the hilt of the sword – perhaps the sword of truth? The idea is to find out what it means for you and not necessarily what you have been told it is. This is about opening to receive your own guidance and inspiration from these and all the stars in the our night sky.

Also prominent this month is the constellation of the Virgin Priestess (a.k.a. Virgo) containing seven main stars. The most visible star in this group is the bright bluish white star Spica, meaning "spike of grain." Higher in the sky and a bit to the right of Spica is the star Denebola which forms the lion's tail in the constellation also known as Leo.

Last month I shared about the star triangles, Spica, Arcturus and Denebola AND Spica, Arcturus and Regulus. If you follow a direct line from Spica to the upper left you will see the bright red star Arcturus.



These three stars Arcturus, Denebola, and Spica form the Spring Triangle best viewed from April to June (see image to the right).

Plus, we have the perfect 30-60-90 degree triangle formed by Arcturus, Spica and Regulus (the heart of the lion). Look East/Southeast to spot both triangles.

There are sacred sites around the world that are aligned with certain stars. The Washington, D.C. capitol is one (it is primarily aligned with Sirius), as is Rennes-le-Chateau, in France, and many other sites around the world.

The location of Rennes-le-Chateau corresponds to the 72-degree position of the Sun rise from true North that takes place on August 15 as described by John K. Young, Ph.D. in his book, *Sacred Sites of the Knights Templar, Ancient Secrets Hidden in Stonehenge, Rennes-le-Chateau and Santiago De Compostela.*

Because Rennes-le-Chateau is at the perfect latitude to capture the sunrise line pointing to the Stellar Triangle,* and to align with at least five other sites at 72 degree angles, as part of perfectly formed, five-pointed star with each point exactly 72 degrees apart from each other; this site was purposely chosen as a sacred connection between Earth and Sky.

*A note about The Stellar Triangle: In his book, Young further points out that Regulus forms a perfect 30-60-90 degree right triangle with Spica (in the constellation of the Virgin Priestess) and Arcturus (in the constellation of Bootes). Young suggests that the Feast Day of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary was most likely chosen because of the stellar connection of Regulus with Spica and Arcturus, and its connection to the Sun rise location of 72 degrees North at certain northern latitudes occurring around August 15.

Arcturus and Spica are two stars linked together

zodiacally at 22 Libra. These two stars are powerful symbols of the Sacred Feminine and the Sacred Masculine. The Tarot Cards depict the constellation of the Virgin Priestess holding the Scales of Justice in her hand. In the tarot cards where the Goddess of Justice is holding the scales is symbolically where Spica is located in the sky, just above the constellation of The Scales. Arcturus is the fourth brightest star in our sky and is located in the constellation of Bootes, the Herdsman (where the meteor shower is this month), and has associations as the faithful guardian, protector, and companion of the Goddess.

This describes how the masculine and feminine principles are different in their expression; but they play equally valid and important roles in the grand scheme of life.



June 2020 Night Sky

June 03 Venus conjuncts the Sun and then rises into the morning sky on June 9 marking the beginning of a NEW 19 month Venus cycle featuring the Rainbow Goddess and New World Story Teller of Gemini.

In 2004 and 2012 Venus was visible crossing the face of the Sun. This year eight years later Venus is passing half a solar diameter north of the Sun, meaning it is not close enough to create a transit visible over the face of the Sun but its still very close to the Sun from the Earth's perspective. It will be 2175 before Venus transits this part of the sky again.

Venus rises into the morning sky and on June 09/10 about 45 minutes before the Sun at a -4.1 magnitude. By June 20 Venus is rising 80 minutes before the Sun brightening to a -4.5 magnitude.

By the end of June Venus is raising two hours before the Sun visible on the Galactic Edge having risen as Morningstar with Aldebaran the brightest star in the Hyades marking the eye of the bull in the Hyades

Venus stations direct on June 24. (see image to the right for more details and click on the image to access the link)

Venus shines brightly for most of June at -4.7 magnitude.

Mercury is the only planet visible in the evening sky as June begins and Mercury is reaching greatest elongation from the Sun at 24° on June 4.

Mercury shines at magnitude +0.4 and sets about an hour and 45 minutes after the sun during the first week of June.

Mercury is visible well below the stars Pollux and Castor by June 12. Mercury quickly disappears from the evening sky going retrograde on June 17 catching up to the Sun on July 1.


Jupiter and Saturn rise about 15 minutes of each other about an hour before midnight as June begins but they rise about an hour after sunset by the end of the month rising earlier and earlier each Night.

Both Jupiter and Saturn stationed retrograde in May so are slowly moving back across the stars they had passed last month visible in the constellation of the archer.

As June begins Jupiter and Saturn are only 5° apart. By the end of June they are about 6° apart. Jupiter is increasing and brightness from a -2.6 to a -2.7 magnitude while Saturn begins June at a +0.4 and increases in magnitude to a +0.2.

Mars is rising around 1:45 AM as June begins and around 12:30 AM as June ends. Mars increases from zero magnitude to a -0.5 magnitude this month and reaches a 90° angle to the Sun on June 6 or said another way is square the Sun. This is an event that always happens before Mars stations retrograde something that will happen on September 09 when Mars is at 28 Aries.

On June 8 the waning gibbous Moon passes Jupiter and Saturn.





On June 19 there is a super close conjunction of the Moon with Venus low in the east north east around 30

minutes before sunrise occurring while Venus is still retrograde.

After the Cancer New Moon eclipse on June 20/21 the Moon is visible to the left of Pollux and Castor in the WNW during twilight.

The annual our solar eclipse creating a ring of fire so close to the exact solstice will last in totality for about 82 seconds.

The North Node is with this star most of June. Venus will pass this alignment on August 05 when the North Node and Venus are conjunct.


Solstice Eclipse Magic

The June Solstice or Summer Solstice in the Northern Hemisphere occurs when the Sun crosses zero Cancer (6:24 am PDT). The Summer Solstice is the seasonal marker signaling a time when the abundance of life is at its fullest expression, the most amount of light in a day is available in this part of the yearly cycle. The Solstice and Equinox points form the four gates or four directions of the celestial medicine wheel. These gates are activated by the Sun in a rhythmic seasonal cycle and the Solstice gates are currently aligned near the Galactic Center and Anti-Center, something that happens for a number of years every 13,000 years.

Solstice literally means "stand still of the Sun". This means the Sun rises and sets at the same place on the horizon for three days appearing to stand still. Therefore, the Solstice window of potency is three days, including the day before and the day after the exact Solstice.

At the <u>Turning Of The Ages</u> these timings are calling us to tune in and receive new ways to honor and celebrate a growing conscious relationship with these seasonal cycles. For those in the Southern Hemisphere this is the time of Winter Solstice and the beginning of a new seasonal cycle.





The June Solstice is happening at 2:44 PM exact Pacific time on June 20. This begins this Summer Solstice in the northern hemisphere in the winter solstice in the southern hemisphere. With in hours there is an annual or solar eclipse visible across parts of Africa Asia and the western Pacific creating the possibility of supercharging our intentional Magic. (a cycle that lasts 223 synodic months or about 18.6 years and is used to predict eclipses)

Orion is the High Man (Maybe High Woman?)

Orion is seen as the High Man from a Celtic Perspective and was considered a way to know when ages were changing by that and other cultures.

The Sun and Moon on the hand of the High Man at the June Solstice 2020 is an age shifting, game changing event that we can consciously utilize in our own intentional practice.

When we consider the Galactic Cross at the Galactic Edge (seen in the eclipse image above) has access to the starry light codes from beyond our galaxy we begin to get a sense of how profound this is.

The brightest fixed star in the constellation of Orion (the High Man) is Betelgeuse - meaning "the armpit of the central one". Orion is also referred to as the High Man by the Celts and in some depictions



is seen reaching his hand to the Galactic Cross at the Galactic Edge where the June Solstice Sun Rises. This currently means the Sun at the June Solstice is on the Hand of the High Man.

Marking Orion's shoulder, Betelgeuse is a first magnitude red star the ancients felt bestowed "marital honors, fortune and wealth."

In Page Bryant's book *Starwalking: Shamanic Practices for Taveling into the Night Sky* she describes Betelguese as sending an energy that "helps sustain the flow of life force in all bodies on Earth." The Sun's own radiant life force energy further transmits the energy from Betelgeuse making this an ideal time to tune into this star energy. http://www.pagebryant.com/ http://www.constellationsofwords.com/Constellations/Orion.html

The Sun is conjunct Betelgeuze on June 18, a giant red star marking the right shoulder of Orion, the Hunter; and part of the winter triangle including Sirius and Procyon, known in some cultures as Heaven's Gate or the entry point into this dimension of experience.

Ancient India connected this star to the Vedic storm-god Rudra, who was a form of Shiva, the transformer through destruction and re-creation. This star currently located near the June Solstice, is drawing upon its transformative abilities to assist in this Turning of the Ages renovation of our earthly experience.


Betelgeuse was thought to be a star that encouraged the pursuit of perfection and high level achievement. In these transforming times, the standards or ideals of perfection are not what they once were, as our understanding and perspective changes. 
Path of the June Solstice Eclipse across the planet.

Meteor Showers

June 22-July 07 with peak around 9 pm on June 26 is the Bootids Meteor Shower

Look to constellation Bootes where Arcturus is located. This one is known for very slow meteors. The June Bootid meteor shower will be active from 22 June to 2 July, reaching its peak rate of meteors around June 26/27. The nearly First Quarter Moon may dim meteor viewing a bit before setting around mid-night.

From Tucson, Arizona where I live the radiant of this meteor shower is above the horizon all night, meaning most any time of the night is a good time to see meteors. The radiant is at its highest point around 9 pm so technically a good time to see the most meteors maximizing the visible number of meteors that appear to "rain" vertically



downwards, producing short trails close to the radiant point. Over the course of the night there are fewer

meteors burning up over up in the sky as they enter the atmosphere at an oblique angle, producing long-lived meteors that may traverse a wide area of the sky before vanishing.

It is interesting to note June 27th, 1998, northern sky watchers were blessed to see around 100 meteors per hour for about 7 hours - suddenly streaming out of the constellation Bootes. Similar displays from Bootes were recorded in 1916, 1921 and 1927.

The source of the June Bootids is comet 7P/Pons-Winnecke - orbiting the Sun once every 6.37 years. The comet has an elliptical path so sometimes closer to the Earth and other times further away. Pons-Winnecke last visited the inner solar system in 2002. Each year the Earth passes through a dense spot in the debris stream, creating a meteor shower that is sometimes more spectacular to see than others.
