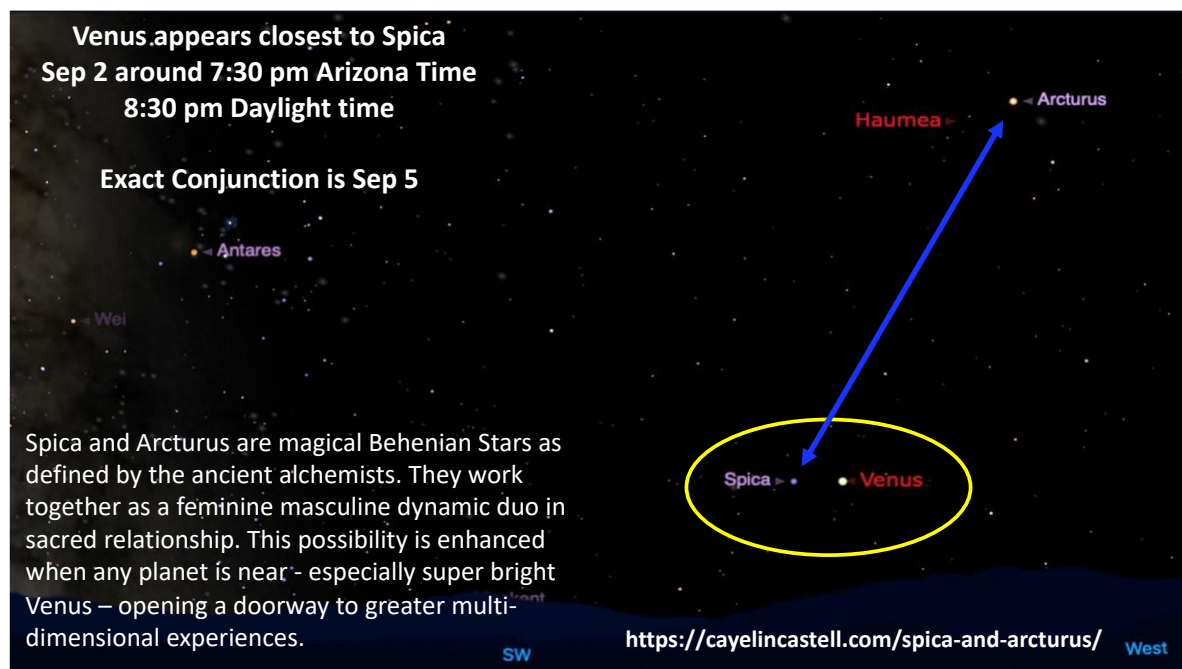

Sep 3, Friday. Waning crescent Moon is near Castor and Pollux exiting the Sacred Hoop of stars. Castor and Pollux were often invoked by sailors for favorable winds suggesting we can do that as planets pass by these stars invoking the favorable winds of change – especially around the mysteries of healthy, happy, home and family. <https://cayelincastell.com/the-twins-castor-pollux/>

September 4, Saturday. Mercury reaches its greatest altitude for observers at mid northern latitudes today though difficult to see because for those in the Northern Hemisphere Mercury is low on the horizon. This is because the term greatest altitude doesn't mean Mercury is high in the sky. Rather currently Mercury is about only 4° above the western horizon. So even though Mercury is shining at a magnitude of +0.0 (technically easy to spot at that magnitude) because it is so low on the horizon it's not easy to find. It's likely it will require binoculars to see Mercury in the west after sunset. When Mercury rises as morningstar in October it will be easier to see.

September 5, Sunday. Venus is shining brightly in the evening sky at -4.1 magnitude meaning it is many times brighter than Mercury. Interestingly Venus and Spica are conjunct exact today with only 1.5° separating them. Spica is a first magnitude star - one of the brighter stars in our night sky. Venus outshines Spica (and Mercury) by several times but oh so amazing to see in the sky together.

In early September when you spot Venus then Spica is easy to find. Spica is in the constellation of the Virgin Priestess (a.k.a Virgo) and both have myths and images of the divine feminine linked with them. The Greeks and Romans saw this constellation as the Great Mother Goddess Cybele with her lion-drawn chariot symbolizing the Lion constellation sitting next to the Virgin Priestess.

Cybele, like many goddesses, had several incarnations or manifestations. Her celebrations included drumming, dancing, singing, and chanting, often all night long. The Greek Goddess Astrea also has associations with the Virgin Priestess constellation depicted in Tarot as the Justice Card, holding the Scales of Justice symbolizing the constellation on her other side.

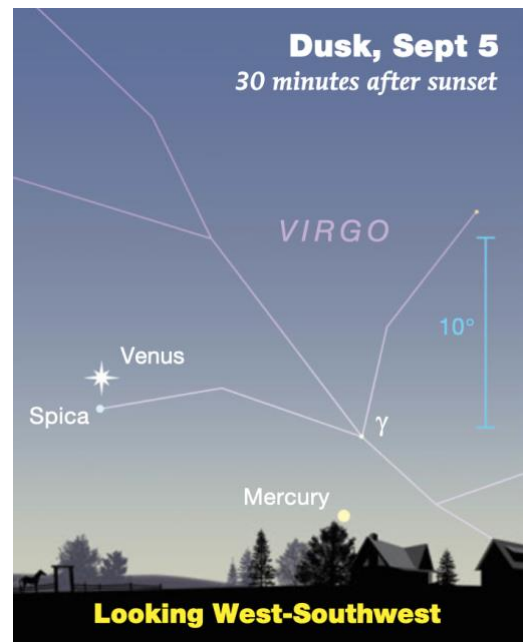
Spica marks the hand of the Virgin Priestess and sometimes is shown as an ear of corn or wheat that she holds in her hand. Other images show Spica as the star that marks where the Virgin Priestess or Goddess holds the Scales in her hand. In Egyptian myth the constellations of the Virgin Priestess and the Scales were described as the Goddess Maat who used the scales to weigh the heart of the dead against her feather to determine the future path of the one who died.

When planets are near Spica it is a great time for intentionally accessing the awareness of the super conscious with the conscious mind as described by Michael Smulkis and Fred Rubinfeld in their book *Starlight Elixirs and Cosmic Vibrational Healing*:

Spica has the ability to transfer awareness from the super conscious to the waking conscious mind and can also enhance lucid dreaming states and psychic abilities. Spica strengthens the physical body in the cervical vertebrae of the spine. This is the physical location in the body that symbolizes the separation of body and mind. So Spica creates an interchange between the separated selves assisting in the remembrance that there is ultimately no separation. Thus, Spica helps to bring the principle of oneness more fully into our conscious minds

Working with Spica anytime you can see her and especially when you can see her with planets near by through intention, meditation, prayers, chanting or any other activities designed to open you to other dimensional experiences – are exceptionally potent. It is important to listen for inner guidance and creating a sacred safe space is recommended for enhancing this possibility.

The Emerald City and the Wizard of Oz reminded us that all we need to find where we want to be is to look within. When planets are with Spica it is important to listen for inner guidance coming from our super conscious higher selves into our physical reality especially when creating a sacred safe space for enhancing



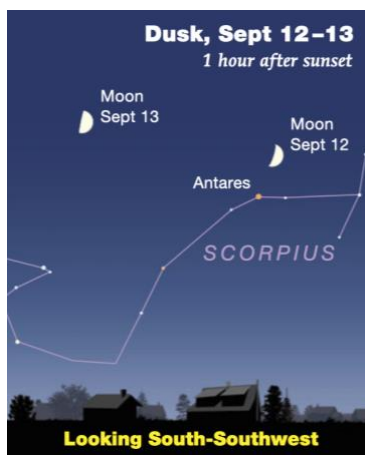
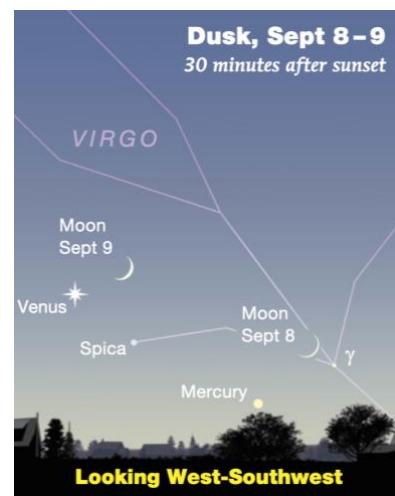

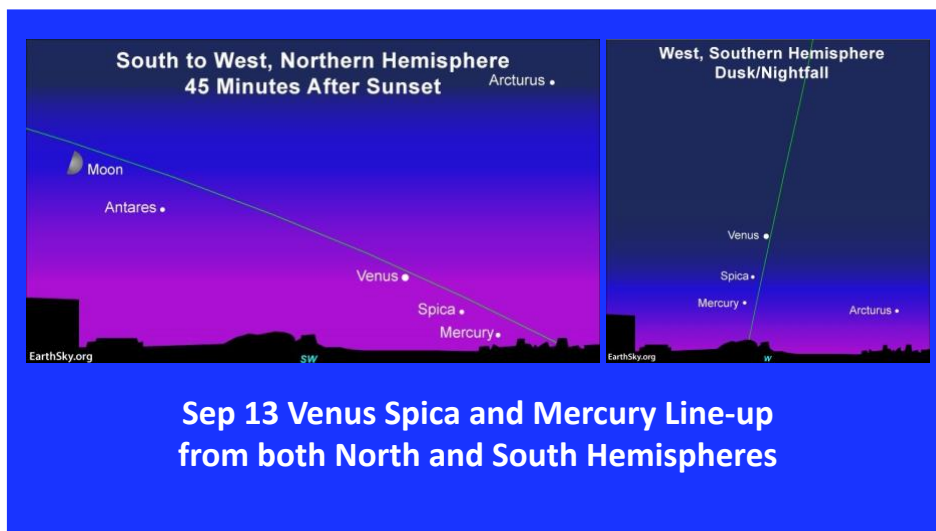
September 9, Thursday. The Moon catches up to Venus marking the fifth time this is happened since Venus rose an evening star in May representing the 5th Chakra reclaiming of the divine feminine voice to speak the sweet truth that enhances all life.

The new Crescent Moon is about 4° to the upper right of Venus. If you're lucky you may see Mercury and Spica both setting within about an hour after the sun. Venus and the Moon will set about 90 minutes after the sunsets.



September 12, Sunday. The Moon is catching up to first magnitude star Antares the Heart of the Scorpion. The waxing Crescent Moon is roughly 3° from Antares. It might be possible to see the Moon 30 to 45 minutes after the sunsets and Antares to the below and to the left of the Moon.

September 14, Tuesday. Mercury reaches greatest elongation at 26.8 degrees from the Sun. This does not necessarily mean Mercury is more visible especially in the Northern Hemisphere.



September 15, Wednesday. Looking SSE the Moon, Saturn and Jupiter are lighting up the night sky.

September 16, Thursday. Moon meets up with Saturn with the Moon about 4 degrees to the lower right of Saturn in Aquarius <https://youtu.be/ONf3axtPGOc>

September 17, Friday. Jupiter and the Moon are together tonight with the Moon 5.5 degrees to the right of Jupiter

September 21, Tuesday. Mercury catches up to Spica though both will be very low on the horizon so not easy to see.

September 22, Wednesday. Exact Equinox. September Equinox Video is 9 min.

September 26 Sunday. The waning Gibbous Moon is about halfway between the Pleiades and the Hyades (including the Royal Behenian Star Aldebaran with Orion rising just before the Sun).

Also today Mercury is stationing retrograde with Spica another Magical Behenian Star. Fun insights into Mercury Retrograde in Libra

Mercury in Libra also has to do with how we communicate in relationship. Layne and Paul Cutright speak to the importance of knowing the intent of our communication when we speak our truth in their book, *Straight From the Heart*.
