

The term "Lunar Standstill" was coined by the archaeologist Alexander Thom, in his 1971 book



Precise Lunar Standstills occur when the Nodes of the Moon are at right angles to the Moon.

This is why it never occurs at the same time as an Eclipse.

The Moon's Nodes are in the signs of Taurus/Scorpio, Aries/Libra, or Virgo/Pisces near the equinoctial points.

The main window is about 3 years surrounding the time when the North Node is near **0 Aries next occurring on Jan 11, 2025**.











The Lunar Standstill Center Point is in 2025 and again in 2043
About every 19 years the Moon Reaches its Most Extreme
Maximum Declination beyond the Sun as shown above.
The Window lasts from about 2 years before to about 2 years after the most extreme declination of about 28.5 degrees North or South!





















The Lunar Node Cycle is about 18.6 years. Every 19 years the Moon returns to its original position and phase with the Sun on the same date.

Inner (a.k.a Minor) and Outer (a.k.a Major) Standstill recurs about every 19 years and the center point lasts at least 3 years.

If you have North Node in Gemini, Taurus, Aries or Pisces you were born during an Outer Standstill

If you have North Node in Sagittarius, Scorpio, Libra or Virgo you were born during an Inner Standstill
